

Fly Tying Contest

3 Divisions (2 for sure)

- Youth – Under 16.
- Amateur – Anyone who has never tied flies for money or taxable remuneration
- Open – Any fly tyer.

Rules:

All flies submitted by participants and tied during the contest become the property of Cumberland Valley Trout Unlimited

The decision of the judges is final

Any participant for the Open category must submit a \$20 non-refundable entry fee with their initial application.

Standard Pattern and Recipes are included with these rules. The rules are posted on the Cumberland Valley Trout Unlimited website at <http://cvtu.homestead.com/>

The entrants may select which flies they wish to submit from the lists for the category which they are entering.

An entrant may submit flies for all three categories. However if an entrant is selected for multiple categories the tyer may only participate in a single category in the final event.

Entrants who have been selected to participate in the final event will be notified of one of the two patterns which they must tie. The second pattern will be made known to them on the day of the event.

Entrants and finalists are responsible for supplying their own tools and materials but not hooks.

For the unknown fly CVTU will provide materials to each contestant to tie the fly. CVTU will provide all hooks to contestants.

The unknown fly will be a fly selected from each list in each category.

Finalists may bring desk reference materials with them to the event.

Finalists may not bring any hooks, completed flies or flies in any stage of construction into the competition area. Tool kits and reference materials will be inspected prior to the start of the final contest.

No coaching is permitted for finalists during the event.

The finalists will have two hours to complete two flies. A known fly and a fly to be announced the day of the event.

Any finalist contestant who leaves the tying area during the competition will be deemed to be completed with the patterns and will not be allowed to return to the vice to tie any additional flies or complete any flies under construction.

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 12
Thread – Brown
Body – Yellow dubbing
Rib – Brown Silk
Tail – Dark ginger hackle fibers
Wings – Wood duck flank
Hackle – Brown and grizzly

Light Cahill (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 16
Thread – Cream
Body – Light cream dubbing
Tail – Light ginger hackle fibers

Wings – Wood duck flank feather
Hackle – Cream

Gray Hackle (Wet)

Hook – Standard Wet Fly Size 12
Thread – Black
Body – Peacock herl
Tail – Red wool tag
Hackle – Grizzly

Coachman (Wet)

Hook – Standard Wet Fly Size 12
Thread – Black
Body – Peacock herl
Tip – Gold tinsel
Wings – Paired white duck quill
Hackle – Brown

Wooly Worm (Wet)

Hook – Standard Wet Fly Size 12
Thread – Black
Body – Black chenille
Tail – Red hackle fibers
Rib – Fine silver wire
Hackle – Grizzly palmered over the body

Gold Ribbed Hares Ear (Nymph)

Hook – Heavy wire nymph hook Size 8
Thread – Black
Body – Dubbed hare's mask
Tail – Hare's mask guard hares
Wingcase – Mottled Turkey quill
Hackle – Picked out dubbing

Pheasant Tail (Nymph)

Hook – Standard wet fly hook Size 12
Thread – Brown
Body – Wrapped ringneck pheasant tail fibers
Rib – Fine copper wire
Tail – Ringneck pheasant tail fibers
Wingcase – Ringneck pheasant tail fibers
Thorax – Peacock herl.

Clouser Minnow (Streamer)

Hook – Size 2 flat eye streamer hook
Thread – White

Eyes – Dumbell eyes painted red with black pupils
Belly – Whitetail deer tail fibers
Flash – Silver Krystal Flash
Back – Chartreuse deer tail fibers

Wooly Bugger (Streamer)

Hook – Size 6 streamer hook
Thread – Black
Tail – Olive marabou
Body – Olive Chenille
Hackle – Grizzly palmered over body.

Mickey Finn (Streamer)

Hook – Size 6 streamer hook
Thread – Black
Body – Flat silver tinsel
Rib – Oval silver tinsel
Wing – Yellow over red over yellow bucktail

Amateur

The entrant must submit three (3) flies for entry into the contest. Those flies will be selected from the following list. Each entrant must submit three different flies.

Hook – Standard Dry Fly size 12
Thread – Black
Tail - Mixed Grizzly and Brown hackle fibers
Body – Gray dubbing
Wings – Grizzly hackle tips
Hackle – Mixed Grizzly and brown

Royal Wulff (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 12
Thread – Black
Tail – Brown bucktail
Body – Red floss between peacock herl at the but and behind the wing
Wings – White calf tail
Hackle – Brown

Renegade (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 12
Thread – Black
Tip – Flat god tinsel

Body – Peacock herl
Hackle – Rear brown, front white

Orange Stimulator (Dry)

Hook – 2X Long fine Wire Dry Fly Size 8
Thread – Fire Orange
Tail – Dark elk hair
Body – Rusty orange dubbing
Rib – Furnace hackle palmered, counter wound with fine gold wire
Wings – Dark elk hair
Head – Amber dubbing
Hackle – Grizzly

Letort Cricket (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 10
Thread – Black
Body – Black rabbit fur
Wings – Black goose quill overtopped with black deer hair
Head – Black deer hair spun and clipped

Elk Hair Caddis (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 16
Thread – Olive
Body – Olive dubbing
Rib – Fine gold wire
Wings – Light elk hair
Hackle – Dyed olive grizzly palmered over body

Hornberg (Wet)

Hook – Standard Wet Fly Hook 2X long size 10
Thread – Black
Body – Flat silver tinsel
Underwing – Yellow calf tail
Wings – Two Whole Mallard Flank feathers
Hackle – Brown and grizzly mixed

Orange Fish Hawk (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly hook Size 12
Thread – Black
Tag – Fine flat gold tinsel
Body – Orange floss
Rib – Fine Flat gold tinsel
Hackle – Light badger hen hackle

Pickett Pin (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly 2X long Size 12
Thread – Black
Tail – Brown hackle fibers
Body – Peacock herl
Rib – Brown hackle palmered
Wings – Gray Squirrel
Head – Natural Ostrich

Casual Dress (Nymph)

Hook – Heavy wire nymph hook Size 6
Thread – Black
Tail – Muskrat guard hairs
Body – Muskrat fur
Thorax – Muskrat fur with guard hairs
Head – Black ostrich herl

Prince Nymph (Nymph)

Hook – Heavy wire nymph hook size 10
Thread – Black
Tail – Brown goose biots
Body – Peacock
Wings – White goose biots
Hackle – Brown

Grizzly King (Streamer)

Hook – Streamer Hook Size 6
Thread – Black
Tail – Red hackle fibers
Body – Green floss
Rib – Fine flat silver tinsel
Wings – Four grizzly saddle hackles
Throat – Grizzly hackle fibers

Thunder Creek Silver Shiner (Streamer)

Hook – Standard streamer Size 10
Thread – Red
Body – Silver tinsel
Wings – Brown bucktail over white bucktail tied forward and pulled back over.
Eye – Painted eye on head optional.

Open

The entrant in addition to a \$20 non-refundable entry fee must submit three (3) flies for entry into the contest. Those flies will be selected from the following list. Each entrant must submit three different flies. In the event the entrant is not selected to participate in the final competition the entry fee will not be returned.

Tail – Golden pheasant tippets

Body – Red floss between peacock herl at the butt and behind the wing

Wings – Matched white duck quill

Hackle – Brown

Rat Faced McDougal (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 12

Thread – Tan

Tail – Light tan elk hair

Body – Natural deer hair spun and clipped

Wing – Grizzly hackle tips

Hackle – Grizzly

Parachute Adams (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 14

Thread – Black

Tail – Mixed grizzly and brown hackle fibers

Body – Gray dubbing

Wing – White calf tail

Hackle – Brown and grizzly tied parachute style

Stimulator Olive (Dry)

Hook – 2X Long Dry Fly Size 16

Thread – Fluorescent Orange

Tail – Dark elk hair

Body – Olive dubbing

Rib – Brown hackle palmered and counter wound with fine gold wire

Wing – Gray elk hair

Head – Amber dubbing

Hackle – Grizzly

Quill Gordon (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 14

Thread – Black

Tail – Blue dun hackle fibers

Body – Stripped peacock herl

Wing – Wood duck flank feather

Hackle – Blue dun

Henryville Special (Dry)

Hook – Standard Dry Fly Size 14
Thread – Black
Body – Olive dubbing
Rib – Palmered grizzly hackle
Wing – Natural gray duck quill
Hackle – Dark ginger

Letort Hopper (Dry)

Hook – 2X long fine wire dry fly hook Size 10
Thread – Gray
Body – Yellow dubbing
Wing – Mottled turkey wing quill underneath natural deer hair
Head– Natural deer hair spun and clipped

Sofa Pillow (Dry)

Hook – 2X Long dry fly Size 6
Thread – Brown
Tail – Red goose biots
Body – Red floss
Wing – Fox squirrel
Hackle – Brown

Paramachene Belle (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly hook Size 14
Thread – Black
Tail – Mixed red and white hackle fibers
Body – Yellow floss
Rib – Flat gold tinsel
Wing – Married sections of duck quill white outside with red center
Hackle – Mixed red and white

Trout Fin (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly hook size 14
Thread – Black
Tail – Duck quill dyed red
Body – Flat silver tinsel
Wing – Married duck wing quill, white over black over red
Hackle – Light ginger

Cowdung (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly Size 18
Thread – Olive
Tip – Flat gold tinsel
Body – Olive floss
Wing – Brown mottled turkey

Hackle – Brown

Leadwing Coachman (Wet)

Hook – Standard wet fly size 12

Thread – black

Tip – Flat gold tinsel

Body – Peacock herl

Wing – Natural Gray duck Quill

Hackle – Brown

Montana (Nymph)

Hook – 2X long heavy wire nymph hook

Thread – Black

Tail – Black hackle fibers

Body – Black chenille

Wing Case – Black Chenille

Thorax – Yellow Chenille

Hackle – Black

Zug Bug (Nymph)

Hook – Heavy wire standard length wet fly hook Size 12

Thread – Black

Tail – Peacock sword fibers

Body – Peacock herl

Legs – Brown hackle fibers

Wingcase – Lemon wood duck flank feathers

Muddler (Streamer)

Hook – Standard streamer hook Size 10

Thread – Black

Tail – Mottled turkey

Body – Flat gold tinsel

Underwing – Gray squirrel tail

Wing – Mottled Turkey

Hackle Collar – Spun deer hair

Head – Natural deer hair spun and clipped

Gray Ghost (Streamer)

Hook – Standard Streamer Hook Size 4

Thread – Black

Tag – Flat silver tinsel

Body – Orange floss

Rib – Fine flat silver tinsel

Wing – Four gray dun saddle hackle over golden pheasant crest

Throat – Four strands of peacock herl, white bucktail, golden pheasant crest

Sides – Two silver pheasant body feathers

Cheeks – Two jungle cock eyes (optional)
Head – Black with a red band

Skykomish Sunrise (Streamer)

Hook – Standard upturned eye salmon hook Size 2
Thread – Red
Tag – Flat silver tinsel
Tail – Mixed red and yellow hackle fibers
Body – Red dubbing
Rib – Fine oval silver tinsel
Wing – White calftail or polar bear substitute
Hackle – Red and yellow mixed
Eyes - Two jungle cock eyes (optional)

Deceiver (Streamer)

Hook – Standard saltwater hook size 1
Thread – Black
Tail – Grizzly saddle hackles with copper Krystal Flash and silver flashabou
Body – Flat silver tinsel
Throat – Natural brown bucktail
Wing – Natural brown bucktail
Collar – Red thread
Eyes – Painted black pupil on yellow back.
